## TO: PARENTS/CARERS

Dear Parent/Carer  
Annwyl Rhieni

We have re-engaged the services of Gwent Music to provide music tuition in the school for the academic year 2018/19. The school has asked Gwent Music to take direct payments from you, instead of you paying the school. This will apply for all music tuition from September 2018.

- Children will continue to be taught in groups of between 3 and 5 children for 20 – 30 minutes each week, depending on numbers and the mix of standards and instruments.
- 34 sessions will be delivered over the school year.
- The cost for small group tuition £39 per term.
- These charges apply for the academic year 2018/19.
- It may be possible, subject to availability, for your child to borrow a Gwent Music instrument for up to a year.

If you wish your child to receive individual tuition, lessons can be provided at £130 per term for weekly 20 minute sessions or £195 per term for weekly 30 minute sessions (34 sessions per year).

If your child is in receipt of free school meals you may be eligible for access to the free school meals music grant. See attached information.

If your child has been receiving tuition in the previous year and would like to continue this term, or would like to begin tuition this term, please enrol your child and make the first payment as follows:

1. Go to [www.gwentmusic.co.uk/parent](http://www.gwentmusic.co.uk/parent).
2. If you already have a Gwent Music Parent Portal account then login as usual. Otherwise, click 'Create an Account' and follow the instructions.
3. Click on 'Enrol for an Activity'.
4. Click 'Music Tuition' and select 'School Name' then click 'Next'.
5. Select the instrument your child learns, or would like to learn, from the list of lessons, then click 'Next' and complete your child's details.
6. You will finally be taken to the Newport City Council payments web page to make payment for the current term.
