### WALK TO KING HENRY VIII SCHOOL: FRIDAY, 11<sup>TH</sup> MAY

Well done to all the pupils who took part in Tuesday's walk. They put great effort into reaching the top and made excellent time.

The forecast for Friday at the moment is cloudy and light rain. Please can you provide your child with suitable clothing; light layers are ideal. Some waterproof jackets are available from the forest school department if your child requires one. School uniform is not necessary. Please also ensure your child has sensible footwear. Walking boots or sturdy trainers/shoes are ideal, due to the terrain of the walk. Please - no sandals or light pumps, as this is a safety risk and your child will not be able to take part.

Children will need a packed lunch, a snack and plenty of drinks. Please could you pack this in a carrier bag with your child's name on it. This will be delivered to the children, at their lunch stop, so they will only need to carry one drink and a snack at any one time. Small ruck sacks are the best option for this and the easiest bag to carry. Free school meal lunches will be provided for those that are entitled.

School have made contact with the owner of 'Simply Brownie', who will be helping us with liquid refreshments on the way. If the pupils would like to purchase a brownie then the cost is £1. Pupils can bring in the money on the day.

We aim to leave school **no later than 8:50 am**. This will allow time for the children travelling on school transport to be registered. Pupils can arrive at school from 8:30 am on the morning, and access the building via the automatic doors at the front by the office. Breakfast Club children will be collected earlier than normal at 8:40 am. Phil Anslow coaches will return the pupils to school by the end of the normal school day.

Thank you for allowing your child to take part in this event, it is a great opportunity for them and an experience that I'm sure they will remember for a long time.
